The society holds a process of auditions each year for the inclusion of new members to its team. This year nine talented members joined the team through auditions held on 20th August, 2019.

Like the last year, this year too, the dancers of Ananta Drishti brightened the RLA College Fresher's welcome, 2019. They also performed at the Northeast Festival held on 13th Feb., 2020 where the members presented a Sikkim fusion folk dance of *Barada Nati* (a folk dance of Uttarakhand) to promote the integrity and diversity present in Indian culture, uniquely the motto of our College. Besides performing in our own college and hosting competitions, Ananta Drishti also performs in other institutes where they have won prizes, bringing laurels to the College.
