Pathway- The Career Counseling and Placement Cell of Ram Lal Anand College, ever since its inception has always strived to heighten its reputation and maintain the merit the college has always been distinguished for. The cell is divided into three departments namely- Marketing and Public Relations, Research and Development & Corporate Communications, and Event Management. The President Nupur Gupta, Vice-President Siddharth Sharma, Heads of the respective departments and a pool of enthusiastic students capable of achieving excellence were selected on the basis of online interviews through the recruitment process.

This year has been a revolutionary era for the cell as the logo of the cell was revamped and the **vision and mission** of the cell were defined. **Mission:** To infuse professionalism into students and provide them with opportunities that complements their talents and skills. **Vision:** To make Pathway a leading and established placement cell across Delhi University colleges.

For the session, orientation was carried out for recruiting students to the team. On 10th January 2022, a total of **30 members** were welcomed aboard which was followed by a classy induction ceremony. Monthly and weekly meetings were proposed and individual roles were discussed. Intra-cell CV- building workshops and mock interviews were conducted and templated CVs were provided to the students.

The Cell also held a 40-hour Skill development Certificate Course on Data Visualization using Power BI & SQL in collaboration with IVY Pro School in online mode from 1st Sep 2021 to 12th Nov 2021.

Apart from this we also organized **three 60-hour each coaching classes for CAT, UPSC and SSC+Bank PO entrance examination** in online mode in collaboration with Facilitate Academy **from 15**th **January 2022 to 6**th **March 2022.** The prime motive was to help the students of our college to prepare from scratch and cover all the sections that come in these exams. Highly skilled and knowledgeable resource persons were called upon to teach and guide the students to score well in these common yet toughest level entrance exams. All the courses were completely **free for students.**

Feedback via feedback forms: we found that the webinars were very informative and fruitful for the students, plenty of sessions were organized for the aspirants to enhance their **soft skills**, and the speakers effectively solved the queries of the students. The speakers that were called upon were **highly knowledgeable** and had **high presentable skills**.



Pathway on Social Media: Pathway crossed 1k+ followers on Instagram, due to the exceptional marketing; the team also received similar applause on Linkedin. This aided us in getting increased footfall for the webinars, and events conducted by us. These collaborations turned out fruitful with reference to our **increased social media engagement** as well. The team brought the audience from **far and wide** and aided the cell's voice to be heard in the farthest corners, making it stand out from the ordinary that **fulfills our vision**.

We are pleased to announce that this year we had **more than 200** internship opportunities and **over 50 placement** opportunities circulated in the college. The major profiles/ job descriptions around which our placements/ internship offers revolved were Sales, Marketing, Content Writing, HR, Business Development, Equity Research, and Graphic Designing. Our range of portfolios through which campus placements/ internships were offered to students included companies like Urban Company, Ditto, Unschool, DE Shaw and Co, Nexdigm, KPMG, Byjus, etc. **The average CTC of 5 LPA**, was recorded in the Placement Drive.

The internship fair- MILESTONE 22', being our pinnacle event, saw 700+ registrations across DU colleges with over 30+ companies offering positions, an overwhelming 70% of paid summer internships with stipend ranging from 5K to 40K per month. Offline desks were set up for registrations The team worked enthusiastically and in a collaborative manner to deliver the best materialistic decorations (craftwork, posters, hoardings, etc.) that were deemed necessary for the Internship Fair- MILESTONE 22' held on 11th and 19th April 22, Hence, making it a successful fair with over 120 students receiving their offer letters from the companies and have already took the first step in their career path with Pathway.

CERTIFICATE COURSE: Data Visualization Using Power BI & SQL

Pathway: The Career Counselling and Placement Cell of Ram Lal Anand College organized a 40 hours skill enhancement course on Data Visualization using Power BI and SQL in collaboration with IVY Professional School.

A total number of 82 students from 3rd year enrolled in the course including three from other colleges and one faculty from computer science.

There were total of 20 classes 2 hours each that were held for imparting skills among the students. The course was started on September 1, 2021 and ended on 12th November 2021.

The entire course was divided into two segments –

- 1. Data Visualization using PowerBI:
 - a. A total of 10 classes were carried out of 2 hourseach.
 - b. The classes were held on alternate weekdays.
 - c. During this segment, one dashboard making exercise and one final quiz was taken by the instructor for theevaluation.

 - b. The classes were held on alternate weekdays.







CERTIFICATE COURSE ON UPSC (CSE)
