Report NSS-2020-21

National Service Scheme or NSS was launched in Mahatma Gandhi's birth centenary year 1969 in 37 Universities with the primary aim to develop the personality of student volunteers through community services. The scheme is currently running in all the states and universities in the country under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. The motto of NSS is "<u>Not Me</u> <u>But You</u>". It helps students to identify the needs and problems of the community and to involve them in problem solving process.

This year, NSS RLAC has been very active in developing the personality of student volunteers and preparing them for future through various community services.

NSS Program Officer, Dr. Rita Jain led the team NSS in 2020-21. Under her guidance, on 10th October'20, NSS team of RLA formally welcomed the volunteers for session 2020-21 through an orientation program with an aim to achieve the goal at making a better society.

After rigorous selection process, the following hardworking and dedicated volunteers of last year were nominated as Office Bearers and Group Leaders of NSS for the year 2020-21.

Sneha Gupta, Mudit Arora, Lokesh, KanavKukreja, Shivam Choudhary, Sarthak Mehta, Nandani Kashyap and Dimple Kumari were nominated as Executive Members of NSS.

Despite the challenge of conducting effectual and worthwhile programmes and activities via online mode amidst the pandemic, NSS RLAC under the guidance of our principal, Dr. Rakesh Gupta and our Program Officer, Dr. Rita Jain been successful to maintain its established dignity.

From an insightful session on 'Online Safety' in collaboration with YOLO in which 23 members took part out of which 12 were females to a heartfelt talk on 'Tree Plantation' by Dr. Santosh George G which was attended by 25 members of which 12 were females; from celebrating Diwali with 'Best out of Waste' theme with 36 members taking part with 12 female members to capturing the 'Emerging Life' around you where 31 participants showcased their talent of which 16 were females; from an informative 'Anti-Drug Campaign' talk by Dr. Rajiv, attended by 28 members with 15 females, to an awareness program on 'Violence Against Women' by Ms. Chandni Khanduja where 29 members took part of which 13 were females.

On the occasion of International volunteers day celebrated every year on 5th of December. 55 volunteers from NSS RLA attended a zoom session with Dr. Devendra Kumar Gupta, founder of Ladli foundation.

Shortly after the fresh admissions in the college for the academic year 2020-21, NSS RLAC had its new recruitment. Out of 150 registrations, 70 new volunteers were added to the team. A team of 120 NSS volunteers was then ready to contribute to the community service and to sincerely follow the motto of NSS.

Our NSS volunteers, Lokesh and Gaurav also participated in State Level Youth Festival which was organized by Directorate of Education, Government of National Capital Territory from 1st

January'21 to provide Youth with a stage to showcase their talent from Narrative Poetry to Creative Writing.

Valedictory Function of National Youth Parliament Festival - 2021 was organized on 12th January 2021 by the ministry of youth affairs and sports, government of India. It will be conducted in the Central Hall of Parliament. 104 Volunteers of NSS unit of RLA joined the function.

Making our volunteers strong in ethics always tops the checklist of NSS RLA. To work in the direction, a HVELS lecture on tolerance and equality was taken by Dr. Rita Mishra from Patang foundation on 15th January 2021 where a total 83 volunteers participated.

NSS RLAC also organized a donation drive in the college campus from 18th January'21 to 25th January'21. The vision of the drive was to connect with the less fortunate through clothes, books, stationaries, etc. All the generous donations received under donation drive were handed over to UMEED NGO by our program officer, Dr. Rita Jain. The exchange took place in the presence of UMEED founder Mr. Subhrajeet Gautam on 3rd February'21. 9 members took place of which 4 were females.

Fit India Movement is a nation-wide movement in India to encourage people to remain healthy and fit by including physical activities and sports in their daily lives. So, NSS UNIT RLA's 52 volunteers were apart of this movement by sending short videos and pictures of themselves doing yoga pose or physical activity.

On 25th January'21, NSS team celebrated the National Voter's Day by organizing a pledge taking ceremony which was attended by 58 members of which 26 were females followed by a digital poster making event where 52 volunteers showed their talent of which 27 were females to mark the foundation day of Election Commission of India with the main objective to educate and encourage young voters to vote during elections.

NSS also organized an intra-college prompt writing competition on 30th January'21 with exciting cash prizes for top 3 positions. With the given prompt as a start, stories woven during the event highlighted the need for social change. The event was successful with registration from more than 100 students. The entries under this event covered various genres and the words of participants reflected an ocean of thoughts whose waves hold the caliber to brew a tsunami. 30 students took part in the competition of which 12 were females.

The series of events from quiz to slogan writing to road safety symbol making from 8th February'21 to 10th February'21 affirmed our commitment to spread awareness about how to avoid accidents and injuries while on the road under the theme 'SADAK SURAKSHA, JEEVAN RAKSHA' while observing 'National Road Safety Month, 2021', formally launched by our Honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi.Symbol making event was attended by 45 volunteers of which 21 were females, slogan writing event was attended by 37 members of which 19 were females and Quiz had an overwhelming participation of 92 members of which 43 were females.

NSS RLAC organized a talk session titled- "Climate Change and Extremes" which was conducted by our guest speaker Dr. Shipra Jain. Dr. Jain is a Post-Doctoral Research associate and Guest Lecturer at School of Geosciences, University of Edinburgh, UK. She has been

closely associated in various roles with Young Earth Systems Scienists (YESS) community from the past 4 years where 80 participants attended the event.

Though they cannot voice their feelings out, animals need love too, like humans do. To help these speechless creatures, NSS Unit of Ram Lal Anand College organized an event aimed at spreading awareness about a cause of which animal lovers, activists and even celebrities have been a part. The event aimed at bringing out animal lovers and show their love and affection byfeeding them. Around 23 participants attended the event.

To mark the occasion of International Women's Day, female NSS volunteers took part in the Fit India Walkathon organized by the ministry of youth affairs and sports at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, Delhi on 8th March'21. The event was graced by the presence of *Mr. Kiren Rijiju*, Honourable Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Youth Affairs and Sports. The volunteers marched around the stadium enthusiastically.15 female volunteers took part in the event.

This was an initiative by PM ShriNarendra Modi was held on 14thmarch 2021. In the same matter, volunteers from NSS RLAC askedquestions from PM by logging intomygov portalandsubmitting their questions. Around 25 volunteers participated in it.

Our Honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi had launched a program 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav' to mark the 75th Independence Day. So, NSS RLAC also celebrated this joyous event by organizing an event where volunteers narrated the historical saga behind monuments and also inspiring stories related to them. 42 members took part in the event where 24 were females.

NSS RLAC volunteers participated in Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji's annual' Pariksha Pe Charcha' initiative on April 7, 2021. While the leaders' concentration on the students is a source of great pride, it was also a learning opportunity for all of the volunteers. 83 participants attended the event. On 10th April NSS unit of RLA organized a session on failures pillars of success by MR Ashok Arora ji, 80 participants participated in it.

The first-ever annual festival 'SANKALP 2021' with the theme 'Volunteerism: An Inspiration in Action' was organized by NSS RLAC from 11th April 2021 to 12th April 2021 via online mode where 78 members took part with 38 being females. Two competitions were held under the fest with exciting cash prizes. <u>Sanrachna</u>: The Storytelling Competition; In this competition, participants were provided with a platform to express themselves through a story they created.<u>Treauropedia</u>: Quizzing event; It was a team event, in which participants were quizzed on their knowledge about 'Social and Historical figures of India'. Also, an informative talk session by Ms. Anupama Datta (Editor- HelpAge India Research and Development Journal) was organized followed by closing ceremony and announcement of results. The closing ceremony was graced by the presence of our honourable Principal Dr. Rakesh Kumar Gupta. The fest turned out to be successful with more than 400 registrations from various institutions all over the country.

During this pandemic, NSS Unit of Ram Lal Anand College has taken many initiatives to provide mental relief to the volunteers, their families and all other youths associated with it. NSS started a helpdesk for blood, plasma and bed availability in DELHI-NCR region via the college website and various social media handles. The volunteers have been continuously active and spread awareness by busting the myths in regard to vaccination drive, every week many digital and handmade posters are made and shared by the volunteers to motivate and aware people about the covid appropriate behaviour. Many videos, posters spreading awareness about COVID 19 were uploaded on the college website. 23 volunteers took part in video making of which 11 were females.

The NSS unit of RLAC welcomed all of its volunteers to a seminar on cyber awareness for women and girl protection on April22,2021. They learned about the complexities of cyber security and supported it by raising awareness in their community. It was a highly engaging event in which everyone took part enthusiastically. 74 participants attended the event.

NSS conducted a session on Laughter therapy the occasion of International Laughter Day on 2nd May 2021. This session was taken by Dr. Umesh Sahgal. It was supervised by Dr. Rita Jain, Program Officer for NSS UNIT of RLAC. 70 participants attended the event.

While awareness plays an important role, the results are achieved by execution. Unit organized a 15-day Yoga camp to celebrate in collaboration with Yoga and Meditation society the 7th International Day of Yoga. Volunteers learned the art and benefits of Yoga from Yoga Gurus Shishir Pokhriyal and Rahul Bhadotiya. Under the initiative of Ministry of Ayush (Govt. Of India), PatajaliYogpeeth, Heartfulness Institute and many other reputed organizations, volunteers from NSS RLAC took part in a 100-day programme, 'Yoga for Unity'. While these examples represent less than a fraction of initiatives, we as a team have conducted numerous workshops and webinars so that the young volunteers indulge themselves in a healthy way of life in the later stages. 82 members took place in the event of which 42 were females.

First intra-unit competition, Tarang, was held on 27th and 28th June where 33 members took part out of which 16 were females. A webinar on basics of disaster management was conducted on 2nd July where 36 members took part of which 14 were females. Further, group presentations was given on World Population Day, attended by 43 members of which 23 were females, members made creative paper bags on Paper Bag Day, attended by 15 members of which 6 were females, on World Youth Skill Day, members got to showcase their talents, 24 members took part of which 11 were females. We also observed World Justice Day through a discussion, attended by 25 members of which 12 were females, Mandela Day through an article writing event, where 17 members took part of which 9 were females and Kargil Vijay Diwas through a doodle making event where 7 members took part of which 4 were females.

Women are leading over men in every field but their rights remains unvalued. To promote awareness about women issues and their rights NSS Unit of RLAC conducted a webinar on "Women issues and legal rights" with Ms. Anmol Kohli being the guest speaker on 5th June

2021. This webinar suggested the volunteers various rights that they were not aware of also how women's safety could help our country grow. 57 participants attended the session actively.

"International NSS RLAC along with AIIMS NYAFI and Ladli Foundation organized a session, "Corona se Daro Na" from 21st May to 27th May 2021 where the volunteers could ask any covid related query to have correct and authentic information about COVID. This session was taken by Dr. Santosh Kumar, an Associate Professor in AIIMS Rishikesh. It was supervised by Ms. Kamini Vaid, coordinator of Ladli Foundation. 42 participants joined the session.

On 24th July, members took part in a storytelling event under the theme "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" and narrated the stories of some of our freedom fighters, 30 members took part of which 14 were females. Members also attended PM's speech on one year of NEP where 34 members were present of which 18 were females. Second Intra unit competition, Tarang, was conducted on 30th and 31st July where 20 members took part of which 11 were females.

On 29th July 2021 NSS Unit of RLAC was invited to attend our Honorable Prime Minister's speech on the completion of one year of NEP which was conducted by the Ministry of education of India. Here he addressed the nation about Indian Sign Language which will become part of the new syllabus and help the students with special needs to learn. 34 volunteers attended the event actively.

From 'Constitution Day' with 29 members of which 15 were females to 'National Youth Day' where 71 members took place of which 33 were females , from 'Makar Sankranti' with 43 members of which 23 were females to 'Basant Panchami' with 23 members consisting of 12 females, from 'World NGO Day' with 62 members of which 30 were females to 'No Smoking Day' with 4 volunteers of which 3 were females, from 'World Heritage Day' with 46 participants consisting 25 females to 'Earth Day' where 29 members took part with 15 being females, from 'World Health Day' with 42 members of which 19 were females to 'National Safety Day' with 67 members of which 35 were females; NSS RLAC had tried to touch every aspect to spread awareness and to reflect the essence of selfless service by underlining the very fact that the welfare of an individual is ultimately dependent on the welfare of society on the whole.


