



## **BASICS OF DISASTER MANAGEMENT**






# WORLD POPULATION DAY

11<sup>th</sup> July, 2021







# WORLD JUSTICE DAY




"Justice consists of doing no one injury, decency in giving no one offense." —Marcus Tullius Cicero

### Nelson Mandela:

"Let Freedom Ring Wherever the People's Rights Are Trampled Upon"

-Nelson Mandela









Mandela was raised in a traditional village of earthen huts in the Eastern Cape of South Africa. He described the singular joys of his wide-open childhood in his autobiography "Long Walk to Freedom". Mandela pursued his own learning actively, curiously and indefatigably in many different settings. As a young lawyer, he helped launch the African National Congress Youth League and led the group's civil-disobedience efforts against restrictive apartheid laws. The South African government banned him from traveling outside of Johannesburg in 1952. Already imprisoned in 1962 for leaving the country without a permit, Mandela and several Spear of the Nation conspirators were tried for treason and sabotage at the South African Supreme Court in 1963. At the outset of the trial, Mandela delivered a 176minute speech, known as the 'Statement from the Dock' or 'I Am Prepared to Die'. Mandela and his ANC conspirators were sentenced to life in prison. He would serve 27 torturous years, mostly within the walls of the notorious Robben Island prison, Nelson Mandela devoted his life-including 27 years in prison- From humble beginnings in a small Eastern Cape village, he became the father of the rainbow nation of post-apartheid South Africa. He described the inedible food, inhumane living conditions and debasing mistreatment in Long Walk to Freedom. He is also widely referred to as "Madiba", which is his clan name, and refers to his ancestral descent.

Painfully separated from his wife and children, Mandela wrote them letters, trying to keep his family relationships from dimming. Mandela was unable to raise his children, but he tried to weigh in on their lives with guidance from his prison cell. In a letter dated November 26, 1978, Mandela advised his daughter Makaziwe on her personal life and professional ambitions.

When the ANC was finally unbanned in 1990, Mandela was released from prison and immediately entered talks to end apartheid and minority-white rule in South Africa. He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1993 alongside South African President F.W. de Klerk. Then in the year 1994, Mandela was elected president of South Africa in the first elections open. to black African voters.

At the time of his death. South Africa went into mourning for the elder statesman. We were privileged to have the benefit of his wisdom for so long. No one can deny that, in our hour of deepest need, the saying "cometh the hour cometh the man" resonated with truth.

रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर

रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर एक महान भारतीय कवि थे। इसके अलावा, वह एक महान दार्शनिक , देशभक्त , चित्रकार और मानवतावादी भी थे। उनके संबंध में लोग अक्सर गुरुदेव शब्द का प्रयोग करते थे। इस असाधारण व्यक्तित्व का जन्म 7 मई 1861 को कलकता में हुआ था। उनकी प्रारंभिक शिक्षा विभिन्न शिक्षकों दवारा घर पर ही हुई। साथ ही इस शिक्षा के माध्यम से उन्हें कई विषयों का ज्ञान भी प्राप्त हुआ। उनकी उच्च शिक्षा इंग्लैंड में हुई। सबसे बढ़कर, रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर ने बहुत कम उम से ही कविताएँ लिखना शुरू कर दिया था।

रवीन्द्रनाथ टैगोर की कतियाँ

रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर ने सोलह साल की उम्र से नाटक लिखना शुरू कर दिया था। बीस साल की उम्र में, रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर ने मल नाटकीय कित वाल्मीकि प्रतिभा लिखी। सबसे उल्लेखनीय, रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर भावनाओं पर केंद्रित हैं न कि कार्रवाई पर। १८९० में उन्होंने एक और नाटक कृति विसर्जन लिखा। विसर्जन शायद रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर की सर्वश्रेष्ठ नाटक कृति है।

इसी तरह, सोलह वर्ष की आयु से रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर ने लघु कथाएँ लिखना शुरू कर दिया था। उनकी पहली लघु कहानी भिकारिणी थी। सबसे उल्लेखनीय, वह बंगाली भाषा की लघु कहानी शैली के संस्थापक हैं। टैगोर ने निश्चित रूप से १८९१ से १८९५ तक कई कहानियाँ लिखीं। साथ ही, इस अवधि की कहानियाँ गलपाग्च्छा का संग्रह बनाती हैं। यह 84 कहानियों का एक बड़ा संग्रह है।

रवींद्रनाथ दैगोर निश्चित रूप से उपन्यासों के संपर्क में भी थे। उन्होंने आठ उल्लेखनीय उपन्यास लिखे। इसके अलावा, उन्होंने चार उपन्यास लिखे।

रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर की कविता का सबसे अच्छा संग्रह गीतांजिल है। सबसे उल्लेखनीय, रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर को 1913 में गीतांजिल के लिए नोबेल प्रस्कार मिला। इसके अलावा, उनकी अन्य महत्वपूर्ण कविताएँ मानसी, सोनार तोरी और बालका हैं।

रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर निश्चित रूप से गीतों में कम नहीं थे। आदमी को एक शक्तिशाली 2230 गीत लिखने की प्रतिष्ठा प्राप्त है। उपयोग में लोकप्रिय नाम रवींद्रसंगीत है, जो टैगोर के गीतों को संदर्भित करता है। उनके गीत निश्चित रूप से भारतीय संस्कृति को दर्शाते हैं । उनका प्रसिद्ध गीत अमर शोनार बांग्ला बांग्लादेश का राष्ट्रगान है। इन सबसे ऊपर, उन्होंने भारत जन गण मन का राष्ट्रगान लिखा।




# (Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav)
