Quru- The Quiz Society of RLAC under the convenorship of Ms. Deepshikha, Assistant Professor, Dept of English, organised a quiz, themed “India@75” on 14th August 2021. The quiz was divided into two rounds: Prelims & Finals. Prelims were held at 3.00 PM & finals at 6.00 PM. The quiz was organised on the occasion of Amrut Mahotsav. It included questions related to events after the independence of India in 1947. The response to the quiz was overwhelming as 446 participants registered. Students hailed from diverse courses, colleges, and universities. In the run-up to the event, our team had partnered with 3 social pages. These included DU Club, RLA Times, and DU Times.

In Prelims, 20 Questions were asked via Google Forms. 15 minutes were given to answer the questions. By the time the forms closed, we had received 165 responses in prelims. Of these 165 responses, just 5 were selected for the final round. Finals started at 6.00 PM, on Google Meet. The meeting had around 30 people, including some spectators. Ms. Deepshikha inaugurated the event and gave a few words of wisdom. She congratulated the finalists and motivated them. There were 4 hosts for the event: Adhiraj Gupta, Aadarsh D Kumar, Medha Kochhar, and Prasoon Chand. Sachin Pal was the timekeeper. Mehak and Vaibhav Shokeen were the points tabulators. The finalists were made aware of the details of the finals. It had 5 rounds. Each round had its own set of rules. The final went on for an hour and was completed around 7. Finally, at 7.10, the suspense was broken and Ms. Deepshikha announced the result and congratulated the winners. It was a neck-to-neck competition, till the very last question. A vote of thanks was proposed by Prasoon Chand and the event ended. The winner and the runner-up were given cash prizes of Rs 2500 and RS 1500, respectively. The top 3 rank holders were given merit certificates.

QUESTION 1.

New Delhi was built as the 8th city of Delhi. Edward Lutyens and Herbert Baker designed the imperial city. A ceremonial boulevard named Rajpath (formerly, Kingsway) runs from Rashtrapati Bhavan on Raisina Hill through Vijay Chowk and India Gate, National War Memorial to National Stadium, Delhi. The avenue is lined on both sides by huge lawns, canals, and rows of trees. Considered to be one of the most important roads in India, it is where the annual Republic Day parade takes place on 26 January. Janpath (meaning "People's Way") crosses the road. Rajpath runs in an east-west direction.

About 150 meters east of India Gate, at a junction of six roads, is a 73-foot cupola. Today, it's empty but once it housed a 70 Foot tall statue. This statue was of X and it was removed and shifted to Y.

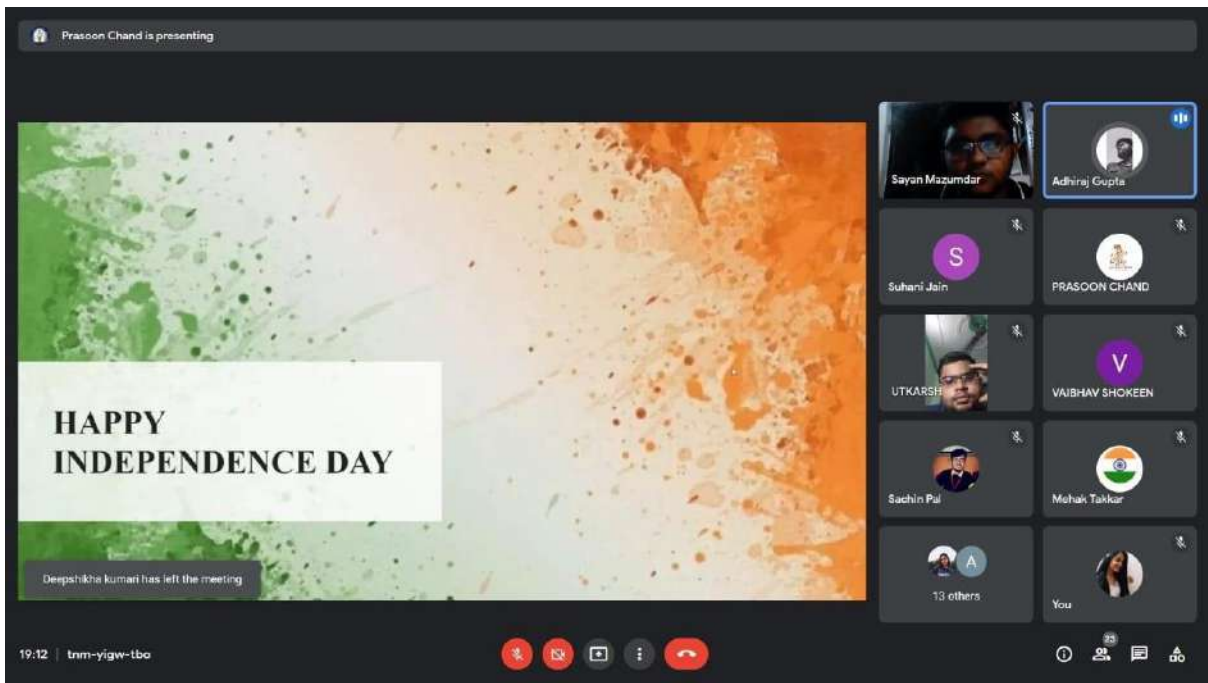
