

Ram Lal Anand College believes in providing quality and affordable education to students from all walks of life and facilitating the development of youth as nation-builders through higher education. 


Milestone 3.0



Enjoy a smooth process with a dedicated point of contact (POC) for seamless communication. It helps the students to simplify the complex corporate jargon and coordinate with the companies for a smooth process.

RECRUITMENT IN MOTION

A message is drafted containing all the necessary details, along with a link to a Google form for registration and a detailed job description (JD). A poster is also signed by the graphics and creatives department of the cell. The message along with the poster is then circulated amongst the students in their respective groups. Interested students register through the Google form link and in case of any query, they can get in touch with the POC.
