4 November 2022





Delhi, organised an Intra-College Handmade Poster Making Competition on 7 November, 2022 in the college's Seminar Hall at 12 noon.


The unit received **90+ registrations** of which **52** marked their participation. An absolute **26 female** volunteers stepped forward and painted their canvases in varying shades of creativity.

12 November 2022








Child sexual abuse is significant but preventable adverse childhood experience.




### ORIENTATION

(Welcome Freshers!)


13 November 2022

# DIGITAL SLOGAN WRITING EVENT


(World Toilet Day)

#### PLEDGE TAKING


#### (Constitution Day) 26 November 2022


In this era of wars and pain,

27 November 2022




The NSS Unit of Ram Lal Anand College, University of Delhi, organised an orientation program for all the newly recruited volunteers of **Batch 2022-23**.

It was made mandatory for all the volunteers to attend the meeting so as to celebrate "The spirit of selflessness and social service".




The existing members shared their experiences with the newly recruited volunteers and the volunteers expressed their will and motive to join NSS.


